2025/26 "Neighbourhood First · Rice-Giving" Scheme

## **Common Application Questions and Rice Station Addresses**

- Q: If the person is not the registered member or service user of the referring organisation, can the social worker still make a referral for the person who needs the support to collect the rice packs?
- A: Yes. However, the referring organisation should assess the information of the applicant by themselves to check if the applicant is eligible to apply the Scheme.
- Q: Will late application submission with special valid reasons be accepted?
- A: In order to be fair to all applicants, the HKFYG will only handle the applications submitted on time. The submission deadline is 31 December 2024. All submissions after the deadline will not be handled.
- Q: Is faxing or emailing the application accepted?
- A: Only original copies of the application are accepted. The application can be submitted by mail.
- Q: How is the deadline of the applications submitted by mail be calculated?
- A: Applications received by mail will be dated by the postmark, which should be on or before the submission deadline. The organizer of the event is not responsible for any delay of mail service or any issues related to loss of mail items.
- Q: Will the application results be given to the applicant directly or be given to the applicant by the social worker who makes the referral?
- A: The HKFYG will email the referring social worker the application result and inform the applicant via mail.
- Q: How will the organizer of the event determine whether the applicant collects the rice packs monthly or every two months?
- A: Based on the principle of reducing the waste of resources, individual applicants who live alone will be collecting rice packs every two months (odd-numbered months). Each rice pack weights 5 kg.
- Q: Can the rice pack be given or sold to others?
- A: Definitely not. The applicant will be disqualified once such action is discovered.
- Q: If the applicant cannot sign for the rice pack due to reading and writing difficulties, will there be any other methods to replace signing?
- A: The applicant can take a photo to replace signing and record.
- Q: If the collected rice pack is found to be problematic, is going to rice collection station to request for a change to another pack possible?
- A: The rice pack cannot be exchanged once distributed. Please check carefully before signing for and collecting it.
- Q: If the applicant does not collect the rice pack according to the designated date and time, can he or she collect the un-collected rice pack next month?
- A: No. The applicant should collect the rice packs accordingly. If the eligible applicant fails to provide valid reasons and fail to collect the rice pack according to the specific time and date arrangements for 3 times, he or she will be automatically regarded as withdrawing from the scheme. The HKFYG will terminate his or her qualification of rice collection and refer the case to social worker.
